



How it all began.

The original suggestion for a social club for older motorcyclists was proposed in a letter by Stephen Dearnley published in the August 1983 issue of Bike Australia, and subsequently an inaugural meeting was held in Sydney on 6th December 1983 when the five people present approved a basic constitution and the Ulysses Club was duly formed.

From that first meeting the club grew strongly, and it now boasts a large and extensive network of members throughout Australia, with sister clubs formed overseas.

The name "Ulysses Club" comes from a poem of the same title by Alfred, Lord Tennyson. It tells how the great Greek hero Ulysses, now middle-aged and securely in charge of his kingdom of Ithaca, is becoming bored with his way of life and longs to go adventuring again with his shipmates of old. It describes very well indeed the sort of person who still has enough spark

to go on riding into middle and later years.

What are the club's aims?

- To provide ways in which older motorcyclists can get together for companionship and mutual support
- To show by example that motorcycling can be an enjoyable and practical activity for riders of all ages
- To draw the attention of public and private institutions to the needs and views of older riders.

What does the club do?

There is information on the club's website www.ulysses.org.au but briefly, the Club publishes a quarterly journal, Riding On and associated website www.ridingonline.com.au, which contains information about forthcoming events, provides a forum for members' news and views and carries articles on topics of interest to older bikers. Branches all over Australia have regular social get togethers, organise rides, rallies, and various outings.


At many Rallies and Odysseys, the club banner is raised as a focal point where members and their friends can join in good company. The Annual General Meeting of Ulysses Club Inc. is held prior to the end of June includes a week of events for members. The venue is a suitable and interesting location anywhere in Australia and the event brings members from afar together to rekindle friendships and make new ones.

Who can join?

Any person who is 40 years of age or above who holds a current motorcycle licence, or who is a spouse or regular partner of a current Ulysses Club member and meets the age requirement. Until you reach the grand old age of 50, you will be a "junior" member, but with full membership rights and privileges. It's just that you might have to help some of the "seniors" off their machines sometimes.



Applications with Learners Permit/Licence will be accepted conditional upon the applicant attaining their full motorcycle licence within 12 months.
